#### PREFACE

The City of Calgary Archives is a section of the City Clerk's Department. The Archives was established in 1981. The descriptive system currently in use was established in 1991. The Archives Society of Alberta has endorsed the use of the Bureau of Canadian Archivists' Rules for Archival Description as the standard of archival description to be used in Alberta's archival repositories. In acting upon the recommendations of the Society, the City of Calgary Archives will endeavour to use RAD whenever possible and to subsequently adopt new rules as they are announced by the Bureau.

The focus of the City of Calgary Archives' descriptive system is the series level and, consequently, <u>RAD</u> has been adapted to meet the descriptive needs of that level. <u>RAD</u> will eventually be used to describe archival records at the fonds level.

The City of Calgary Archives creates inventories of records of private agencies and individuals as the basic structural finding aid to private records. Private records include a broad range of material such as office records of elected municipal officials, records of boards and commissions funded in part or wholly by the City of Calgary, records of other organizations which function at the municipal level, as well as personal papers of individuals. All of these records are collected because of their close relationship to the records of the civic government, and are subject to formal donor agreements.

The search pattern for information in private records is to translate inquiries into terms of type of activity, to link activity with agencies which are classified according to activity, to peruse the appropriate inventories to identify pertinent record series, and then to locate these series, or parts thereof, through the location register. Inventories of private records can also be accessed through the inventory of any civic department to which it might happen to be linked.

Existing inventories of private records are revised as additions of records are received and described at the Archives.

## INTRODUCTION

The records of OCO'88, the organizing committee for the staging of the XV Olympic Winter Games, were acquired by the City of Calgary Archives through an agreement signed 1990 January 22 between The City of Calgary, the Calgary Olympic Development Association (CODA) and the XV Olympic Winter Games Organizing Committee. The process of arrangement and description began before that time with the permission of CODA.

The records described in this inventory are part of accession PR-90-001. The original extent of the entire collection of records from OCO'88 at the time of the accession was approximately 620 containers. With records received as the result of an accrual of OCO'88 material in 1991 August, the total extent of the Sports Group material after arrangement and description is 17 m.

This inventory was originally prepared by Glennda Leslie in 1991, and was revised to follow the <u>Rules for Archival Description</u> in 1992 October.

## **ADMINISTRATIVE HISTORY**

By the spring of 1982, shortly after the formation of OCO'88, positions for six Vice Presidents had been added to its organizational structure. The Vice President, Sports, appointed in July, was Brian Murphy who came to OCO after having served with the Calgary Olympic Development Association (CODA). He reported to the Senior Vice President of Operations, Pat Mitchell, and was responsible for all athletic events and liaison with National and International Sports Federations. Murphy retained this position until the reorganization of OCO in early 1986 at which time his title was changed to General Manager, Sports. In 1986 September, Murphy was replaced by General Manager Bill France within the Sports Administration Department of the Operations Group, headed by Vice President, Bruce Cleveley.

Records from the Sports Group received by the Archives do not reflect much of the early activity of this administrative unit. Mission reports from the Sarajevo and Los Angeles Olympic Games may be found in Series I. Brian Murphy's files are limited and are often found throughout other series (see Series V, the records created by the Sports Coordinators). Some early correspondence on bobsleigh and luge events, a collection of photographs and slides on site selections and some reference material represent the only consolidated set of records in the Sports Group from Brian Murphy (Series VI). In fact, a more informative collection of Murphy's correspondence can be found in the records of the Executive Group, particularly in Series XI. President W. Pratt. General Administration. Correspondence and Reference Material. 1983-88. No doubt, the

records of the Operations Group, yet to be processed, will also contain material from the early years of this administrative unit.

Some of the earliest records in the Sports Group created by someone in the upper echelons of OCO's administration are from John Pickett. Prior to joining OCO, Pickett had worked in Ontario assisting in the development of sports facilities. He served in positions with a recreational emphasis for local, provincial and federal governments, and began to work with the Canadian Olympic Association (COA) in 1973. He was the Assistant Chef de Mission for the 1976 Olympic Winter and Summer Games in Innsbruck, Austria and Montreal, respectively. Then, in 1979, he served as Director of Games Mission Administration to the Pan American Games in Puerto Rico. He maintained that capacity for the Lake Placid Winter Olympics in 1980. He came to Calgary after having been the Executive Director of the COA.

Initially, Pickett was responsible for International Relations as a member of CODA. As Vice President of Games Operations for OCO in 1982, Pickett's responsibilities included Olympic Villages, transportation, security, ceremonies, tickets and clothing (in other words, non-sporting activities). He, like Brian Murphy, reported to the Senior Vice President of Operations, Pat Mitchell. In the summer of 1984, Pickett's title was changed to Vice President, Olympic Services, but the records indicate an overlap of his two vice presidential titles until at least 1985 April, or later.

While the records created by John Pickett and received by the Archives tend to reflect his mandate as Vice President of Games Operations, they also indicate his work with National and International Sports Federations, work also within the mandate of

Brian Murphy as Vice President of Sports. Cindy Bowman worked very closely with John Pickett in the capacity of Associate, Services (more formally, Associate, Olympic Services) from at least the fall of 1985. Ms. Bowman had been active in several sports in Calgary before becoming an employee of CODA in 1981 April. She continued her work with OCO after the Winter Olympics were awarded to Calgary, initially in the Games Operations Department, while at the same time working on several Alpine World Cup Organizing Committees and with the 1983 Western Canada Summer Games organization.

One of Bowman's major responsibilities as Associate, Services was to coordinate dealings with the National Olympic Committees (NOCs) and the various international sporting federations (IFs). Her work was rewarded in the spring of 1987 when she was appointed Coordinator, NOC Services/Relations with the Sports Group. She reported directly to Vice President, Bill France. These records may be found in Series I.

By 1987, the Sports Group was an entity of its own with the mandate to coordinate sporting events for the pre-Olympic competitions (known as Preview'88) and those of the XV Olympic Winter Games, in total, 176 events. To the ten medal sports of alpine skiing, bobsleigh, biathlon, cross country skiing, figure skating, ice hockey, luge, nordic combined, ski jumping and speed skating were added one demonstration sport-curling--, two demonstration events--freestyle skiing and short track speed skating--, plus one exhibition event--disabled skiing.

Within the mandate of the Sports Group were the responsibilities of coordinating and training personnel; preparing the Games schedule and arranging for approvals by

international sports federations; scheduling training times for participating Olympic teams; addressing national Olympic committees' requirements; acting in liaison with international sports federations to ensure all equipment and facilities met technical requirements; and acting in liaison with provincial and national sport governing bodies to ensure their involvement both before and during the Games. Within the Sports Group, there was the Sports Department and NOC Relations section, both of which reported to the Vice President. (An organizational chart of 1987 December has the Coordinator of NOC Relations reporting to the Manager, Sports, but in practice this does not seem to have been the case.) Volunteers made up a large part of the Sports Group with 2300 of them organized into various sports committees. (From the Official Report)

Bruce Wasylik was appointed Manager of the Sports Department after the reorganization/review of OCO in 1986. (In some organizational charts, he is given the title, General Manager). Eventually all Sports Coordinators (six in total) reported to him although not all of these Coordinators were appointed at the same time. As for Wasylik's own records, other than those general files found in Series IV, very few records were clearly created by him. Some files, when packed by OCO staff at the conclusion of business, were given the generic term "Sports Management," and the records themselves do not clearly indicate who created them. These may be found in Series II.

The records of the Sports Coordinators make up one of the largest series of records from the Sports Group received by the Archives (see Series V).

Advertisements for people to fill the positions of Sports Coordinators appeared as early

as July of 1984. At that time, the Sports Coordinator was to report to the Vice President, Sports and to be "responsible for acting as the liaison with the twelve sports chairmen and the local, provincial and national Olympic winter sports governing bodies," as well as to assist the Vice President of Sports with the smooth operation of that unit. By May of 1986, the duties outlined for this position put less emphasis on the liaison between the sports chairmen and the sports coordinators. The other responsibilities seemed to have remained the same. The distinction between those volunteers appointed as Sports Coordinators and those appointed as Sports Chairmen was that Sports Coordinators were venue oriented positions while Sports Chairmen were sport oriented positions. In general, the Sports Coordinators reported to the Manager, Sports while the Sports Chairmen reported to the Venue Chairmen in the Operations Group.

Bill France took over as Vice President of the Sports Group from Brian Murphy and remained in that position until the end of the Games. Records from his office are also very limited, but general correspondence and reference files may be found in Series III.

For a brief period in 1987, the organizational charts for the Sports Group indicate that Medical Services was part of the Sports Group, but by Games time, this administrative unit was part of the Operations Group, and no records remained within the records of the Sports Group. The Final Reports for the Sports Group may be found in the records of the Communications Group (see separate inventory).

#### SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The records of the Sports Group consist of six series, each of which is introduced by an "Archival Description" section and a "Scope and Content" note. Several of the series consist of a number of "sub series," with the result that the descriptions at the series level can be quite detailed.

Three of the series (II, IV and V) are the result of the work of more than one records creator. The records in Series IV came from the offices of Brian Murphy and Bruce Wasylik, and those in Series V are clearly identified as being the result of the work of several Sports Coordinators; however, the origin of the materials in Series II is less certain.

The records of the Sports Group are predominantly textual, but must be considered to be "multiple media" because of the existence of photographic images and oversize documents within the series. Photographic images have either been placed in acid-free enclosures or, in the case of slides, placed into appropriate "sleeves" and then into a binder for storage. The oversize material consists of a number of maps, plans and schedules as well as material used for presentations. These have been removed from original file folders and placed either into oversize, flat Hollinger storage boxes, or into map folders and then into a map cabinet. Listing of all oversize material from each series may be found at the end of the "File Listing" section for each series. Graphics, audio cassette tapes, and some computer discs are also part of the records of this Group.

As in many of the series in the OCO'88 records, a number of documents in telefax form were found in the Sports Group. Because of the rapid deterioration of these records, they have been photocopied for preservation. In the most severe cases-where the fading of the document was so extreme as to make photocopying impossible--the "faxed" documents have been transcribed.

A number of boxes of OCO records intended for the City of Calgary Archives were mistakenly sent to Kestrel Data Inc., the company responsible for the storage of OCO's financial records. This material was transferred to the Archives in 1991 August. All of the accrued material from the Sports Group was from the records of Brian Murphy, the first Vice President of the Sports Group (Series VI)

#### **DESCRIPTION OF RECORDS**

I. Sports Group, NOC Relations, Coordinator Cindy Bowman, Correspondence and Reference Material. -- 1981-1988. -- 3.25 m of text and other material.

**Archival Description:** By Games time, NOC [National Olympic Committees] Relations was an important administrative unit within the Sports Group of OCO. Although communications with the national Olympic committees from participating (and non-participating) countries was an important and constant aspect of OCO's work, NOC Relations was not made a separate administrative unit until the spring of 1987.

These records give some indication of the various divisions and departments of OCO which carried out the work of NOC Relations. One constant through-out was the work of Cindy Bowman, who, prior to the formation of OCO, had been a full-time employee of the Calgary Olympic Development Association (CODA). After the incorporation of OCO, Ms. Bowman initially worked within the Games Operations Department as the Calgary Mission Program Coordinator for the delegations which travelled to the 1984 Winter Olympics in Sarajevo and to the Summer Games in Los Angeles. At that time, Ms. Bowman worked closely with John Pickett, the Vice President of Games Operations. When Pickett was named Vice President of Olympic Services in 1984, Ms. Bowman's title was changed to that of Associate, Services. Later, when NOC Relations came under the jurisdiction of Sports, Ms. Bowman reported to Brian Murphy, Vice President, Sports. By the spring of 1987, she had been appointed Coordinator of NOC Relations within the Sports Group and reported directly to Vice President Bill France.

Because of Cindy Bowman's close working relationship with John Pickett, the records of the NOC Relations administrative unit include some of Pickett's correspondence as Vice President of Games Operations. These records may be some of the earliest Vice Presidential correspondence in the OCO records, apart from those in the Executive Group. Records from Brian Murphy and from Bill France, the two Vice Presidents of the Sports Group, are quite limited and very general in their nature. Again, the records of the Executive Group are a better source for much of their correspondence.

**Organization and Arrangement:** The records of NOC Relations have been divided into five sub series, as follows:

OCO Delegations to Sarajevo and Los Angeles - These records were created by John Pickett in his capacity as Vice President, Games Operations and the Chef de Mission for the Canadian team to Sarajevo and Los Angeles. Those records relating to the "missions" remained with the NOC Relations material.

While these records, particularly those from the mission to Sarajevo, are not arranged in a strictly alphabetical way, the original order of the records has been maintained for the most part. Those files relating to the Sarajevo mission precede those relating to the Los Angeles mission. Correspondence relating to the sponsors for these delegations include standard form letters to sponsors along with other correspondence. Files containing personal information have had restrictions placed upon them.

NOC Country Files - The records in this sub series relate more directly to the work of Cindy Bowman. Although much of the information is repetitive, the files do give an indication of the number of types of problems or concerns which arose in OCO's dealings with delegations from the various National Olympic Committees and as arrangements were being made for the participants of the Games.

These files are arranged alphabetically, with much of the correspondence being routine and often in "fax" format. As well, these files contain reports, itineraries, pamphlets, lists and forms. Often, included are black and white ID photographs of NOC delegates.

NOC Mailings and Miscellaneous - These files, created by Cindy Bowman, consist of a number of mailings which were sent to the National Olympic Committees informing them of arrangements as they were being made in Calgary and also often including questionnaires seeking information from the NOCs on their expected involvement in the XVth Olympic Winter Games, i.e. the number of athletes being sent and in which events, the number of officials, etc. A few files relating to individual countries or to individual programs may also be found in this sub series.

As well, this sub series consists of a number of files on ANOC, the Association of National Olympic Committees. Programs and reports from meetings of the Association and from an ANOC visit to Calgary in 1986 February are included.

NOC Seminar, 1986 February - These files, created by Cindy Bowman as Associate, Services, outline the arrangements made for delegates from National Olympic Committees which met in Calgary in 1986 February. As well as routine correspondence, reports, schedules, questionnaires and the like, this sub series also contains a number of colour photographs of the participants and activities surrounding this Seminar. Many of the people featured in these photographs are as yet unidentified. Some of the proceedings of the Seminar were captured on cassette tape, and these may be found in the file entitled "NOC Seminar, Feb/86, Translation/Interpretation,

1985-1986." Computer diskettes found in this sub series have yet to be reformatted for appraisal purposes. Some bank receipts were removed for disposal.

NOC Fragments - This sub series arrived at the Archives as a group of "Miscellaneous" records from the NOC Relations section of OCO. Created by Cindy Bowman, some of these files, such as those on the NOC Seminar, relate to material within other sub series of the NOC Relations records. As well, some files relate to Commonwealth or University Games in Edinburgh, Scotland and Kobe, Japan respectively, and to AENOC, the Association of European National Olympic Committees.

**Scope and Content:** Besides routine correspondence, the files in these sub series contain manuals and handbooks, clippings, plans, graphics, photographs and negatives, sound cassette tapes, agreements, transcripts, minutes and itineraries, reports and financial statements. Computer diskettes have yet to be reformatted so that their contents can be appraised.

The other material includes 64 photo prints, 49 photo negatives, two contact sheets, three blueprints, three sound cassettes, two postcards, one diskette, one pin.

The titles are based on the contents of the series and box labels.

# II. Sports Group, Sports Management, Reports, Schedules and Reference Material. -- 1977-1988. -- 2.2 m of text and other material.

**Archival Description:** These records consists of various types of reports, reference material, sports schedules and material to be appraised from computer diskettes. They were sent to the City of Calgary Archives under the label "Sports Management." Brian Murphy, the Vice President and then the General Manager of Sports until the fall of 1986, and/or Bruce Wasylik, the Manager of Sports, were most likely responsible for their creation, but there is little in the records to help determine this. Thus, the title "Sports Management" has been maintained.

**Organization and Arrangement:** There are five sub series in this series as follows:

<u>Site Inspection Reports and Schedules</u> - Most of the reports in this sub series are from World Cup events in Lake Placid, Colorado or from various games held in Europe. The reports have been placed into three folders, the first of which contains several colour photographs of the Paskapoo area before it was developed into Canada Olympic Park. The final two folders contain the reports, which were in no particular order. A listing of those reports is given below.

<u>Committee Reports and World Cups</u> - As in the first sub series, many of the reports listed below were as a result of competitions held in Lake Placid. Some also came from the Sarajevo Olympics and other European games as well as from a Test Event held at Canada Olympic Park and from the Skate Canada competition held in Calgary in 1987. Again, there is no particular order to these reports.

<u>Final Reports and Results</u> - Many of the reports in this sub series were submitted by the various Sports Chairmen of OCO, as follows:

Many reports consist only of competition results, but often information manuals, organizational charts and minutes of Team Captains' meetings are included along with a report.

<u>Miscellaneous Reports</u> - As in other sub series, some of the reports in this group of records are from Lake Placid, Sarajevo as well as Calgary. There is no apparent arrangement to these files.

<u>Schedules and Reference Material</u> - This sub series includes several miscellaneous information and training manuals, lists of OCO personnel (which have been restricted because they contain personal information), a couple of video cassettes and numerous sports schedules. Computer diskettes of sizes 5 l/4" and 8" await conversion to a readable format so that their contents can be appraised.

The information manuals found in the second file of this sub series are for the following: Alpine Skiing, Owasina Village, Bobsleigh, Figure Skating, Ice Hockey and Luge.

The contents of the two video cassettes is unclear and neither may be of any value. The purpose of the VHS video is unknown; the tape contains footage of speedskating events with a timing log and numbers which may represent particular skating events. The second video cassette is in PAL (European) format.

Oversize material consists of an organizational chart of the Sports Group and schedules of the various sporting events as follows: Canmore Nordic Centre; Alpine Nakiska; Canada Olympic Park; 1988 Olympic Winter Games; Schedule of Competitions and Practices [Ice Hockey/Figure Skating]; Speed Skating, Olympic Oval; Short Track Speed Skating, Max Bell Arena; Curling, Max Bell Arena; Calgary 1988 Olympic Winter Games Schedule.

The files in this sub series have been maintained as they were sent to the Archives. The organizational chart of the Sports Group and graphic schedules of each event may be found in two locations--initially, in the first files of this sub series, and, secondly, in an oversize, flat Hollinger box (Box #13). Besides the sports schedules, oversize box contains overhead transparencies of schedules, budgets, and lists of sports, international federations and the IOC organization.

The other material consists of 141 photo prints, 35 plans, 12 computer diskettes, 11 transparencies, three cultural historic items, three maps, and two video cassettes.

The title of the series is based on the contents of the series and box labels.

III. Sports Group, Vice President Bill France, General Correspondence and Reports. -- 1982-1988. -- .39 m of text.

**Archival Description:** These files came to the Archives under the title "Sports Management," but they are clearly the files of Bill France. In 1986 September, France was appointed General Manager of the Sports Administration Department which was then part of the Operations Group. In 1987, when the Sports Group was created, he was named Vice President and remained in that position to the end of the Games. These are the only records created by Vice President France which were retained by the Sports Group.

**Organization and Arrangement:** There are two sections to these files, the first being a number of general correspondence files arranged in alphabetical order. These are followed by a group of Progress Reports which were the formal reports of OCO to various international sports federations and to the IOC on the progress of operations in Calgary. **Archival Description:** Most of these general reference files were created by Bruce Wasylik, the Manager of the Sports Department from 1987 to the end of the Games, but many were also created by Brian Murphy, who was Vice President of Sports within the Operations Group of OCO from 1983 to 1986. With the reorganization of OCO in early 1986, Murphy was appointed General Manager of Sports, a position he retained until the fall when he was replaced by General Manager Bill France. When France became Vice President of the Sports Group in 1987, Bruce Wasylik took over as Manager, Sports.

**Organization and Arrangement:** The records arrived at the City of Calgary Archives in no particular order, but, with the exception of some "Correspondence" files, which have been placed at the beginning of the series, an alphabetical order has been imposed to ease research. Files containing address labels only were removed for disposal, although some samples were retained.

The titles are based on the contents of the series and box labels.

V. Sports Group, Sports Department, Sports Coordinators, General Correspondence and Reference Material. -- 1983-1988. -- 7.65 m of text and other material.

**Archival Description:** The role of the Sports Coordinators was to act as "the liaison with the local, provincial and national winter sports governing bodies," and to perform "various technical administrative duties required in the Sports Division." Initially, the Sports Coordinators reported to the General Manager of the Sports Division, Operations Group. By Games time, Sports Division had become one of the six major Groups of OCO, and the Sports Coordinators reported to the Manager of the Sports Department in that Group.

**Organization and Arrangement:** This series represented the largest in the group of records from the Sports Group. They have been arranged by sub series according to sport or venue and coordinator. In some cases, the Sports Coordinator was responsible for more than one sport at a particular venue. The sub series are as follows:

Alpine - Elenore Kubik - Elenore Kubik, the Alpine Sports Coordinator, reported to Bruce Wasylik, Manager, Sports in late 1987 and early 1988. Once the Venue Management System was implemented for Games time, Ms. Kubik was often referred to as Supervisor, Nakiska or Coordinator, Nakiska and she reported to the Alpine Chairman, Alf Fischer. Her administrative files are general in nature, consisting mainly of routine correspondence, but with some minutes included, especially of Race Organizing Committee (ROC) meetings, and inspection reports from technical delegations. On occasion, the correspondence of Brian Murphy, who was Vice President of Sports from 1982 to 1986 can be found in these files.

There is an extensive set of photo prints in the "Alpine" file. These consist of a series of black and white photos of a "Solar Analysis" of Nakiska, i.e., the changing shadows and sunlight on Mount Allan, and colour photo prints of an alpine delegation inspecting the developing ski runs. Neither set of prints came with negatives, and both are glued to paper backings. Copy negatives will be made of these photo prints as budget allows to ensure proper preservation of these unique images.

Note: The Final Report (see file of same name) indicates that Production and Advertising produced the Results books for the NOCs and IFs

The files are in alphabetical order. Many files contained oversize drawings, blueprints or plans. These have been removed and placed into oversize boxes or map folders for adequate storage and have been labelled according to the OCO Group, Series, Sub series and folder title, with cross references to the original folders.

Restrictions have been placed on some files containing personal information.

<u>Canmore Nordic Centre - Kevin Pennock</u> - Kevin Pennock was the Sports Coordinator for the Canmore Nordic Centre and in charge of cross country skiing, biathlon and nordic combined events. He reported to the Manager of Sports, Bruce Wasylik.

The records are arranged according to the following groupings (or sub-sub series): Minutes; General Correspondence and Reports; Schedules, Manuals and Maps; and Artifacts.

Once again, oversize material has been removed from the file folders and placed either into oversize storage boxes or into map folders. The series, sub series and folder titles identify the original location of the material, as do cross references within the original files.

A test event manual for Biathlon may be found in the sub series: Hockey/ Figure Skating - Keith Magill, which is described below.

Oval/Max Bell - Brian MacPherson - Brian MacPherson was responsible for the three sporting events held at two venues, curling and short track speed skating at the Max Bell Arena, and speed skating at the Olympic Oval. As with other Sports Coordinators, Brian MacPherson reported to the Manager of Sports, Bruce Wasylik.

Brian MacPherson's records were placed in coloured file folders according to sport--curling in red folders, speed skating in green folders and short track speed skating in yellow folders with a few files in blue file folders (beginning with file number 13.0 Language Services, below) which seemed to have been maintained separately from the records kept in yellow folders. Because the coloured folders have been replaced with archival folders, the sport to which the records refer has been added to the folder title in square brackets. These records were also given a filing number system which has been maintained. Two folders of purchase requisitions were removed for disposal.

A binder of I.S.U. Communications, a publication of the International Skating Union, was not given a number in the filing system. These publications have been removed from the binder and have been placed in the sub series following the files related to Short Track Speed Skating, below. A report from 1986 entitled "Indoor Short Track Speed Skating Travelling Report" may be found in the sub series: Hockey/Figure Skating - Keith Magill, also described below.

The box numbering system is a continuation of previous sub series.

Canada Olympic Park - Shawn Balog - Shawn Balog was the Sports Coordinator at

Canada Olympic Park (COP) and was responsible for the sports of bobsleigh, luge and ski jumping. In some correspondence, Ms. Balog was referred to as the Coordinator, Bobsleigh/Luge. She reported to the Manager, Sports Department, Bruce Wasylik, although a 1987 July organizational chart indicates that she reported directly to the Vice President of Sports at that time.

The records in this sub series were not created exclusively by Ms. Balog. They also reflect the work of Brian Murphy, who was both the Vice President of Sports and the General Manager of Sports until 1986 (see Series VI, the records of Brian Murphy), and Bruce Wasylik, who was Supervisor of Sports at COP in 1986 before he became the Manager of the Sports Department in 1987 January. Some material from Bill France, the Vice President of Sports from 1987 to the end of the Games may also be found in this sub series.

This sub series consists mainly of general correspondence and reports. Agenda, minutes and some oversize plans and blueprints are included, along with charts, manuals, booklets, itineraries, budget information and some photo prints.

Most of the records in this sub series came to the Archives labelled "Miscellaneous files," a title consistent with the filing system(s) used for this material. Several sets of files were created with identical or very similar titles. Some attempt has been made to lessen any confusion which could result from this system; however, duplication of file titles does remain. Many folders were empty when they arrived at the Archives and these have been removed.

Boxes 22 to 24 contain folders of timing tapes and results sheets from the men's and ladies' luge competitions. Although all the results sheets from this material have been retained, only samples of the timing tapes have been kept.

Oversize material has, in most cases, been removed to oversize storage boxes or to map folders and cross references have been added to the original files.

The box numbers are a continuation from the previous sub series.

<u>Hockey/Figure Skating - Keith Magill</u> - Keith Magill was the Sports Coordinator in charge of all hockey and figure skating events during the Olympics. This involved several venues, the Olympic Saddledome, the Stampede Corral and the Father David Bauer Arena. He reported to the Manager of the Sports Department, Bruce Wasylik. When OCO's organization was switched to the Venue Management system just before Games time, Magill also reported to the Sport Chairmen, Joyce Hisey for Figure Skating and George Kingston for Hockey.

Files in this sub series were arranged according to sport, either hockey or figure skating and then alphabetically. The title of the particular sport has been added to the

file title for clarification. Box numbers are a continuation from the previous sub series. The final two folders in Box 37 and those in Boxes 38, 39 and 40 are miscellaneous files from the Saddledome and Corral, primarily, which came to the Archives in no particular order. Some slides, negatives and contact prints are also part of these files.

<u>Technical - Larry Kovac</u> - The records of the Technical Coordinator, Larry Kovac, reflect many areas of responsibility, such as Disabled Skiing, Announcers, SAIT activities, the results of Preview events, the staging of a seminar in early 1988 on technical aspects of the Games, as well as the official eligibility forms filled out by competing athletes.

The files in this sub series are arranged according to the following sections: Announcers, SAIT, Disabled Skiing, Technical Seminar, Preview'88 Results, and finally the Eligibility forms of competing athletes which are arranged by sport and then by country within each sport.

In the section on Announcers, some of the information found in the file, Announcers Handbook, 1987-1988, was duplicated in subsequent files. These folders were removed for disposal, but files were retained in cases where the material in them was not an exact duplication of previous material.

**Scope and Content:** Most of the information in this series is in the form of general correspondence; however, quite often minutes of meetings and reports are found as part of the general correspondence files. Rarely were they ever filed as a separate set of records. Often notes have been added to the file listing to indicate when minutes or reports can be found in a general correspondence file.

Oversize material from all sub series within this series have been placed in oversize boxes (Boxes #50 and #51) or into map folders. The material in oversize boxes is from all sub series within the series, and has been labelled according to series, sub series and file title. The material placed into map folders is divided by sub series, and each folder is labelled according to the series title, sub series and folder titles.

The other material consists of 246 plans, 108 photo prints, 68 photo negatives, 44 cultural historic items, 42 maps, 21 blueprints, five forms, and one slide.

The title is based on the contents of the series and box labels.

VI. Sports Group, Vice President Brian Murphy, Correspondence, Reference Material and Photographs. -- 1981-1986. -- 2.23 m of text and other material.

**Archival Description:** Brian Murphy was appointed to the position of Vice President, Sports in 1982 July after having served in the Calgary Olympic Development Association (CODA) as a member of that organization's Hosting Committee. Murphy came to CODA as a former school teacher and a private businessman, the owner of several sports clubs in Alberta, and he remained with OCO until 1986. His titled varied, from Vice President of Sports within the Operations Group, to General Manager. In the fall of 1986, Murphy was replaced by Bill France who became the Vice President of the Sports Group and remained in that capacity until the end of the Games.

**Scope and Content:** There are six sub series within this series of records: Day Files; Bobsleigh and Luge; Contracts; Reports and Miscellaneous Reference Material; Budget Information; and Photographs and Slides. Much of the material reflecting Murphy's activities as Vice President of Sports comes as the result of an accrual of records from OCO'88 material stored at Kestrel Data Inc. These records were transferred to the City of Calgary Archives in 1991 August and added to Series VI of the Sports Group in 1991 September. Previous to this, most of Murphy's material had consisted of the photo prints, negatives and slides, plus the textual material in the Bobsleigh and Luge sub series.

The records from the series indicate Brian Murphy's involvement in the CODA bid process and the development in the early years of Olympic facilities, including numerous trips to events and sites in Europe and North America. Much of this information is in the form of colour photo prints or slides. Besides the Day Files, the textual material (some of it labelled "Miscellaneous" when it arrived at the Archives) concerns the development of the bobsleigh and luge facilities and events, and reflects meetings with the Canadian and provincial associations for these two sports. Also part of this series of records are contracts from proposals for the development of Olympic village sites which were undated. The textual material concludes with reports, manuals and reference material, and finally with Sports Group budget information.

Very few of the images were labelled before they were sent to the Archives, although their original packaging indicated that, for the most part, Brian Murphy was the photographer. In many cases, Murphy was a subject in the photographs, in which case the photographer is unknown. Lori Allan was another name listed as being responsible for taking some of the photographs. When the subjects or the locations of the images were known by the Archivist, these identifiers have been added to the photograph envelope. Although the photo prints have been divided into separate folders with varying titles, images from the same locations often appear in folders with different titles. More extensive identification is required on these images to clarify these

identifiers. The folders of negatives will have to be compared to the photo prints at that time as well.

The slides seem to have been from presentations set up by OCO members. It is unlikely that Murphy was the photographer here. Many of the slides are duplicated, but because these were "presentations," the groups of slides have been maintained as they were found in the slide carousels which were sent to the Archives. These have been placed into an appropriate slide preserver and binder, marked Box 5.

A group of oversize drawings have been placed into a flat storage box (Box 14), and one oversize blueprint was removed from its original folder and placed into a map folder, labelled and cross referenced.

**Restrictions:** Some files have been restricted because of the personal information they contain.

The other material consists of 308 photo negatives, 261 photo prints, 216 slides, 52 plans, nine drawings, six postcards, three cultural historic items (artifacts), one pin, and one blueprint.

The title of the series is based upon the content of the records.
