

# 4th Quarter 2023 Statistical Report

#### **Executive Summary**

- Total violent crime in the 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter was 4% higher than the 5-year average and 5% more than the 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter of 2022. 2023 saw 12% more violent crime than the 5-year average and 9% above volume noted at the end of 2022.
- There were four homicides during the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of 2023 compared to a five-year average of 6. None of the four homicides were domestic-motivated. By the end of 2023 there were 21 homicides, a 12% reduction from average. Three of the 21 homicides in 2023 were domestic-motivated.
- Reported sexual offences were 11% below average in the 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter but in line with volume noted in the 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter of 2022. 2023 year-end volume was comparable to the five-year average.
- Robberies in the 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter were similar to the five-year volume and saw a 25% increase compared to the 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter of 2022. At the end of 2023 robberies were 8% higher than average (largely driven by an increase of person robberies) and 9% above volume in 2022.
- Assaults increased by 9% during the 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter compared to the 5-year average with most assault categories registering increases. Assaults were 13% above average for 2023.
- The presence of weapons in violent crime was 7% higher than the 5-year average during the 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter with increases across multiple weapon types. By the end of 2023, there was a 12% increase noted compared to the 5-year average.
- The number of victims of domestic violence declined 3% from the 5-year average during the 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter and by the end of 2023 volume was in line with the 5-year average.
- Property crime volumes were 10% below the 5-year average in the 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter of 2023 with reductions across most property crime types. By the end of 2023 property crime was 7% below average.
- The total number of young offenders identified was 6% above the 5-year average during the 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter with a 9% increase in violent crime (driven by a 41% increase of assaults) and a 5% increase of property crime (spread across most property crime types). The number of young offenders in 2023 was 15% above the five-year average.
- Youth victims of violent crimes decreased 7% during the 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter compared to average driven mostly by reductions in sex offence victims and robbery victims. By the end of 2023 there were 11% more youth victims of violent crime compared to the 5-year average.
- The total number of police service requests during the 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter was 4% higher than the five-year average. Police attended an average of 963 calls a day. This is 3% lower than the 5-year average.
- Citizen use of the online reporting system was 29% higher than the 5-year average during the 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter, with almost 42 reports per day. Online citizen reports were 44% above average by the end of 2023.
- Disorder calls accounted for an average of 222 calls from the public during the 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter of 2023. There was a 6% reduction in the 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter compared to the five-year average with declines noted across most disorder call types. The end of 2023 saw a 6% decrease of disorder calls from the five-year average. The most notable disorder call type increases in 2023 include disturbances, mental health concern and unwanted guests.

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#### REPORT NOTES

Most of the statistical data in this report is derived from the Calgary Police Service records management system (SENTRY). Disorder data is derived from the Computer aided Dispatch (CAD) system. Data is compiled by the Corporate Data and Analytics Team of the Bureau of Service & Community Support.

Reporting is based on the most serious offence in the incident. Please note that offences are assigned to the month in which the offence was *reported*, which is not necessarily the month the offence occurred. The reported date is the first point in time at which the police were notified of the offence and reporting lag may vary due to circumstances (these are typically property crimes where the victim did not report the offence until a later date, or was unaware of the loss until a later date, or late-reported sexual assaults). Also note that "attempted" offences are included in these totals. Violent crime, excluding robbery, is counted by the number of victims, using the most serious offence against the victim. Robbery, and all other crime, is counted by incident using the most serious offence in the incident. Of note, cases are often cleared months and sometimes years later. Consequently, clearance rates for previous years may appear to be much higher than those of the present year. Cases "cleared by charge" and those "cleared otherwise" are included in these clearance rate totals.

Homicide counts are provided by the homicide unit. <sup>3</sup> Robbery and all other crimes, as well as selected domestic non-criminal incidents, are counted at the incident level using the most serious offence in the incident.
