

## BULLETIN #004 CLIMATE STRATEGY AND TAXI STANDS – COMMITTEE MEETING

March 2023

INDUSTRY PARTNERS,

On May 10, 2022, Council directed Administration to report back with a plan of how Vehicle-for-Hire Public Safety will support The City of Calgary's goal of reaching net zero by 2050. The plan was to include:

- 1. An assessment on reducing the daily number of vehicles that rely on 'on the move' circuits for fares.
- 2. An understanding of the number of Transportation Network Companies licences versus taxi licences to ensure a competitive balance and an equitable environment in the livery market.
- 3. A plan whether to add more city-wide taxi stands.

On March 16, 2023, Administration will brief the Community Development Committee of its findings. Members of the public can attend the committee meeting in person or watch live on Calgary.ca. However, public members cannot make a presentation or discuss the item with Committee. Meeting minutes will be available approximately one week after the meeting.
