

Marda Loop Main Streets

Upcoming Utilities Work & 33 Ave. S.W. Detour

Unrelated to the Marda Loop Main Streets project, The City of Calgary will be doing essential work on a sanitary line in Marda Loop over the September long weekend. This is critical maintenance to protect the wastewater capacity of the community.

The work will be done on 33 Avenue S.W. between 22 and 21 Streets S.W. and will require the full closure of westbound 33 Avenue. There will be a detour in place taking vehicles and bicycles north along 21 Street, west on 32 Avenue, and south again on 22 Street. There will be a safe space for pedestrians to walk along 33 Avenue and localized, temporary "no parking" restrictions will be in place.

This detour will be in place from Saturday, September 2 to Monday, September 4 (pending weather).

This Friday, September 1 is the <u>Marda Loop Night Market</u>. To support this event, there will be an additional detour put in place tomorrow at noon which will be removed after the Market is closed. **34 Avenue will be closed to vehicle traffic between 18 and 19 Streets S.W.** There will also be temporary, localized "No parking" signage in place. Pedestrians will have a safe route to get to and from the event. Please be aware of detour and directional signage onsite and be patient when travelling in the area.
