

## Marda Loop Main Streets Upcoming Detour Information

We have a few updates to share with the community, specifically about detours to support our partners' work. Our team has created a video outlining these upcoming pieces of work in more detail (a note that we created this video last week before the deep freeze rolled into Calgary!) Our contractor will resume Main Streets work in April. Rest assured, we will be in touch with the community to share our construction timelines and anticipated milestones once they are confirmed. We plan to host drop-in office hours beginning in February, should you wish to discuss the project or ask any questions in person. We'll share the details of when and where these will be in the coming weeks.



## 34 Avenue and 20 Street S.W. Northbound Traffic Closure

Vehicle traffic will be restricted northbound from 34 Avenue on 20 Street S.W. This closure is in effect from January 15 until the end of the month, depending on weather conditions. This closure will support ENMAX's work burying the overhead utility lines in the area. ENMAX expects its work in Marda Loop will be complete this summer. ## Temporary One-Way on 33 Avenue from 20 to 22 Streets S.W.

There will be a temporary, phased return to one-way westbound vehicle traffic on 33 Avenue between 20 and 22 Streets S.W. This change will begin on January 29 for approximately 3-4 weeks, depending on weather conditions. This configuration will support ATCO's gas line relocation work.

The one-way detour will then shift east as ATCO's work progresses. It's likely that a portion of 33 Avenue S.W. will remain in a one-way configuration until our Main Streets work begins this spring. At that time, the full one-way will be implemented along 33 Avenue S.W. for the duration of our construction season like it was last year.

ATCO is beginning their work earlier than anticipated, which is why the one-way will return sooner than originally expected. The good news is that ATCO has dedicated additional resources to completing this work as efficiently as possible. ATCO expects its work in Marda Loop will be complete in late-March or early April.
