

Marda Loop Main Streets Two-Way Traffic Resumes on 33 Avenue S.W. on December 4




The morning of Monday, December 4, two-way traffic will resume on 33 Avenue S.W. This configuration will remain until next year's construction season. We hope this supports Calgarians shopping local this holiday season. Once the project is complete, both avenues will return to two-way traffic.

34 Avenue S.W. will temporarily remain one-way eastbound from 22 to 18 Street S.W. This is to accommodate the work of our partners at ATCO and ENMAX. Maintaining the one-way provides a safe, protected space for these crews to quickly set up and get to work; it decreases the amount of prep time required for each piece of work.



Where: 33 Ave 20 to 18 St What: Two-way traffic and parking both sides When: Nov 30, 2023 * until March 1, 2024 (*weather dependent)



Other: Private development(s) may start end of 2023 - local impact to parking

Temporary closure at 33 Avenue & 19 Street S.W.

Vehicle traffic northbound on 19 Street from 33 Avenue S.W. will be temporarily restricted as part of ENMAX's work to bury the overhead utilities.
