

UPDATE: Upcoming Construction | Gladstone Connect Community Drainage Improvements Project

May 2024

As part of the Gladstone Connect Community Drainage Improvement project, The City is investing in utility infrastructure upgrades and replacing aging water and sanitary mains to enhance resident safety and protect vulnerable areas from damage caused by stormwater flooding.

Construction Schedule and Road Closures

The scope and schedule of the planned work that was previously communicated has changed. The road closure schedule is as follows and may be subject to change depending on weather and ground conditions.

May 21 – May 27

- 11 St between 5 Ave and Kensington Gate closed.
- Intersection of Gladstone Road and 11 St closed.

May 27 – May 30

- 5 Ave partial closure with single lane alternating traffic.
- 11 St from 5 Ave to Gladstone Road closed.
- 11 St between 3 Avenue and Kensington Gate closed.

May 30 – June 2

- 5 Ave partial closure with single lane alternating traffic
- Closure in northbound cul-de-sac
- 11 St between 5 Ave and Gladstone Rd closed.
- 11 St between 3 Avenue and Kensington Gate closed.

June 2 – July 6

- 11 St between 5 Ave and Kensington Gate closed.
- Intersection of Gladstone Road & 11th Street closed.

Construction Impacts

- An increase in on-site construction activity including construction crews, vehicles, and heavy equipment. For safety, fencing will be installed around construction areas and on-site signage installed.
- Noise, vibrations, and dust. Noise levels will be monitored.
- Temporary water service, and possible water shut-offs for nearby buildings.
- No access to on-street parking.
- Regular hours will be 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday to Saturday.

Detours

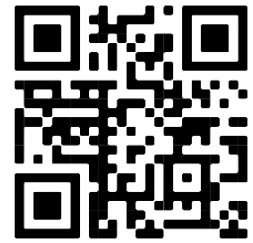
If transit detours are required, full transit detour information, and temporary stop locations will be posted to calgarytransit.com/service-updates and on the mobile Transit app.

“K” parking permits can be used to park throughout the entire “K” zone for the duration of construction. The “K” parking permit is valid in all “K” permit blocks and two-hour parking blocks (that do not require payment). A parking zone map can be found at maps.calgary.ca/CalgaryParking.

Temporary Water Service

During construction, some residents and businesses will be provided a temporary water supply, and access to your property will be required. Before construction starts, a contractor representative will request entry to your property. Should it be necessary to disrupt water service, all affected customers will receive notice at least a day in advance. Please note that internal fire suppression systems will not work if a building is being supplied by temporary water services.

We thank residents for your patience and understanding while we complete this necessary work to protect the community from flood risk.
